

### **Notice of Public Hearing**

City Council approved a proposed increase of the Fiscal year 2019-2020 for the City of Rocksprings Tax Rate to 0.5511/\$100 value. The first public hearing was held Tuesday, August 27, 2019 and the second public hearing is scheduled for Monday, September 9, 2019 at 5:30pm.

The proposed 2019-2020 Budget\*\* for the City of Rocksprings beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 is set for Monday September 9, 2019.

Proposed budget reflects \$404,475.00 revenues for the General Fund with budgeted expenses of \$341,892.00. The Utility, Sanitation and Maintenance Funds reflects \$643,900 revenues with budgeted expenses of \$616,250.00.

Interested citizens are encouraged to give oral or written comment at the scheduled meetings. A copy of the Budget figures are available for public review between the hours of 8AM and 5PM weekdays.

\*\*The Mayor Pro Tem filed the proposed budget pursuant to authority granted by section 22.037 of the Local Government Code. Brian Wood was elected as Mayor at a general election held on May 4, 2019. Mayor Wood submitted his resignation on August 8, 2019, which became effective on August 16, 2019.
